During **Public Forum**, Terry Pastika, from Citizens Advocacy Center, spoke of the need for statement of economic interest from Economic Development commissioners. More below. Dan Van der Molen spoke regarding funding of Historical Museum, suggested charging an entrance fee and soliciting donations.
