Accounts Payable dated 12-31-05 totaled \$788,322.90. Highlights included:

- Elgin Sweeping Services, Inc., sweeping & second leaf cycle, \$47,120.
- Elmhurst St. Patrick's Day Committee, community grant, \$10,000.
- Mc Cann Industries, Inc., industrial loader backhoe, \$67,400.
- Metro Paramedic Services, Jan. ambulance service, \$18,917.
- Nicor Gas, monthly gas, \$37,767.

Consent Agenda included the following:

Change in DuPage Water Commission charter contract, to include towns not included in original contract, but now seeking inclusion.

MCO-01-2006 Increase in purchasing authority of the City Manager, from \$10,000 To \$20,000. Emergency purchasing is increased from \$20,000 to \$30,000.

MCO-02-2006 Approval of liquor license for Mitoodle Noodle restaurant, bringing Total number of licenses to 16.

MCO-03-2006 Ordinance increasing Deputy Chief of Police to two, Commander to Four, sergeants to eleven, total force to seventy. Changes will provide more Supervisory personnel.

MCO-04-2006 Amendment to City Code relating to door-to-door solicitors, including Increase in fees, background checks by police, oath-taking by applicants.

ZO-01-2006 Conditional use permits for Power Mart gas station, drive-through Car wash and restaurant, and pylon sign, at 572 W. Lake St. Hours of Operation of car wash and restaurant, and illumination of the property Will be restricted.

O5-P-08 Amendment of zoning ordinance regarding senior citizen housing. City has reviewed assisted living zoning requirements and has limited it To non-commercial areas.

City Manager Borchert presented an overview of the five-year capital expenditures Budget, emphasizing road improvement and additional parking provisions.

Mayor Marcucci read a letter from Mayor of Waveland, Mississippi, thanking Elmhurst for its support following Hurricane Katrina.
