Council recognized the members of York high school Peer Jury and Timothy Christian Mock Trial members, winners of numerous State championships.

During Public Hearing, residents of River Glen Ave. spoke regarding Gables of Elmhurst development at North and Rt. 83. All were opposed to the proposal. Most cited traffic dangers and preservation of green space and wooded area. Council later rejected idea if reconsideration of the issue.
