During **Public Forum**, Council heard from numerous speakers a few complained about flooding on Oct. 2, others about parking at North Ave. east of Rt. 83. Most were from the Van Auken/Crestview area and wanted 4-way stops for minimum two intersections along Van Auken.

Accounts Payable dated October 16, 2006, totaled \$744,067.45. Highlights included:

- American Light, streetlight supplies, building repair and maintenance, \$56,354.
- Associated Technical Services, Ltd., leak location, \$13,554.
- CTR Systems, In c., sewer cleaning and televising, \$31,071.
- Down Under Construction, Berens Park storm sewer, water services upgrade, \$15,771.
- DuPage Water Commission, fixed cost and consumption, \$182,653.
- Helm, Steve & Assoc., professional services, \$13,440.
- Poco Paulson Oil Co., gasoline, \$15,713.
- W. Daniels, Churchville One Room Schoolhouse, \$24,644.

Consent Agenda included the following:

- Purchase of 3 Ford 500 SELs, Elmhurst Ford, \$54,300.
- Purchase of 3 Chevrolet vehicles, with trade-in, Larry Roesch Chevrolet, Inc., \$50,052.
- 2006 Sidewalk repair program (slabjacking), \$31,175.
- Request to Development, Planning and Zoning Committee for study of rules and responsibilities of landlords when renting single family homes.
- 2006 Watermain improvement project, \$543,582.
- Item 5q, concerning easement vacation at 636 Crockett, was pulled from Consent Agenda and held to next meeting, at request of Ald. Szczepaniak.

Council voted 11 to 3 for Ald. Bram's minority report for 4-way stop signs at Crestview and Van Auken. City engineers maintained that too many signs caused motorists to speed up or ignore them, and violates the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, the standard for judging this need. Voting Nay were Ald. Jordan, Mulliner and Leader.

MCO-18-2006 Council voted unanimously to approve Ordinance establishing Historic Preservation Commission.
