Council recognized ten students from Immaculate Conception school, who won first place in national competition of DestiNation Imagination. Team was cited for “superior technical achievement.” Most of the Public left after recognition ceremony.

Council heard from a citizen, upset over continued problems from contractors at neighboring property. “My life is a living Hell.” (City Mgr. Borchert indicated that problems are resolved, citing involvement with social services, engineering analysis and independent professional engineering report.)
