Council recognized Brynhaven and Edison Schools for their DestiNation Imagination teams, who scored highest in national competition.

During Public Forum, Council heard from Darlene Heslop, who questioned propriety of Ald. Bram's membership on the Senior Citizens Commission. She also wondered why some were still serving on Commissions after 15 years or more. Ald. Rose pointed out the ex officio status of alderman on all Commissions.
