During Public Forum, Council heard from David Cusack, 0S539 Kirk, who presented a petition from 20 of his neighbors regarding development in new hospital neighborhood, especially Harvard Street. Neighbors are concerned about berm heights, regarding flooding, parkways, and adequate space for walks.
