The Policy Committee is made up of Mr. Carlquist, Mr. Spaeth and Mr. Thrall. Mr. Thrall is the chair. Superintendent Krizic and Assistant Superintendents Tom McCann and Lisa Smith also were present.

The Board members were presented with policy that needed to be changed due to “No Child Left Behind” legislation.

- 4200 Certified Staff: The word “rectified” was changed to “recertified” and “By the end of 2005-2006” was removed.
- 4305 Qualifications (of support staff): Addition of the need for a “statement of approval” issued by the State Board of Education.
- 5215-6 Homeless Children: Requires immediate admission of a homeless child, includes language of what is to be done should admission be denied.
- 3225-3 School Safety Program: Changes amount of emergency evacuation drills from 2 to 3.
- 3225-3.1 Child Sex Offender and Murderer Community Notification Act: States that a child sex offender who is a parent or a student may be on school property and sets the terms for when and how these individuals may be on school property.
- 5425-2.1 Right of Inspection: Adds the requirement that military recruiters and institutions of higher learning may access student names, addresses and telephone numbers unless the parent or guardian requests (in writing) that the information not be disclosed.

The policy committee discussed the possibility of using advertising on District property based on a proposal received by the athletic department at York. Further information was requested.
